- Ongoing Fellowship Program (5 fellowships will be provided for each meeting in 2009). (Academia, journalist, government, regulator, member)





Outreach Activities Cont'

- Participation and support at other industry related events: AfTLD.com, ATU (ccTLD)
- AfriNIC is a partner of the 6Deploy consortium whos projects are funded by the European Union and supported by 13 organizations composing the consortium (including Cisco, AfriNIC, LACNIC, RENATER, Consulintel, etc.) to support the deployment of IPv6 in Europe and developing countries.

- Increased participation in Internet Governance initiatives
