- Hosting a box under AS2905 in Johannesburg

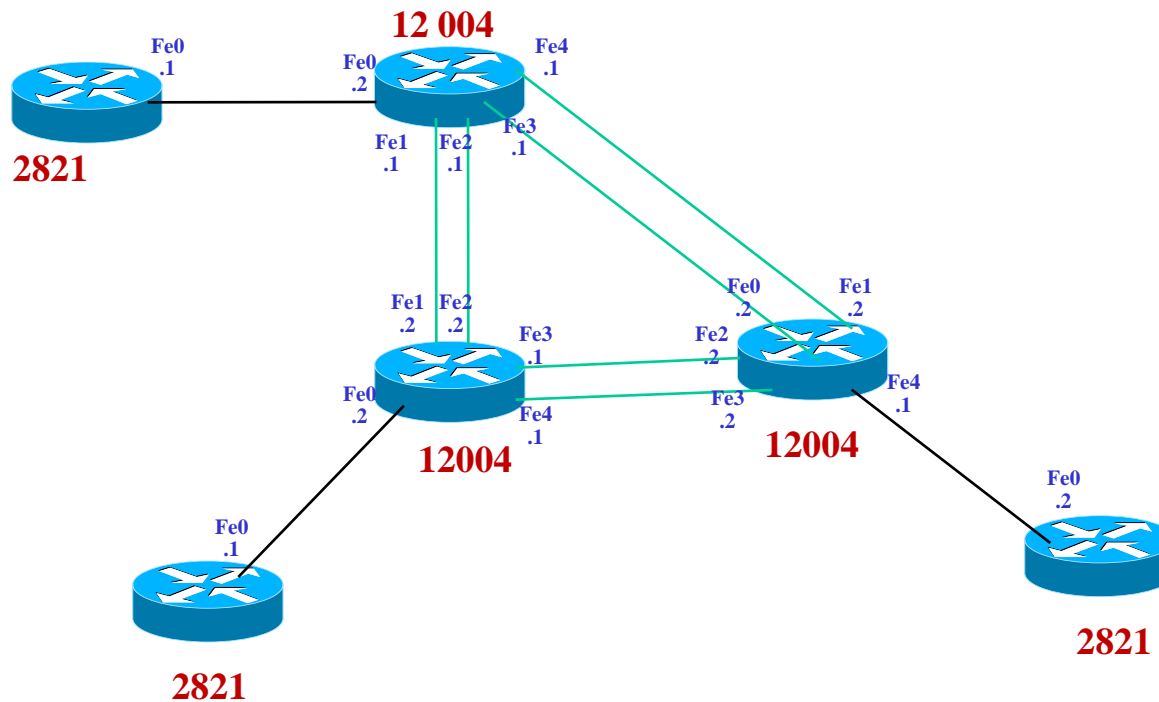

 - A reservation system to handle the utilization

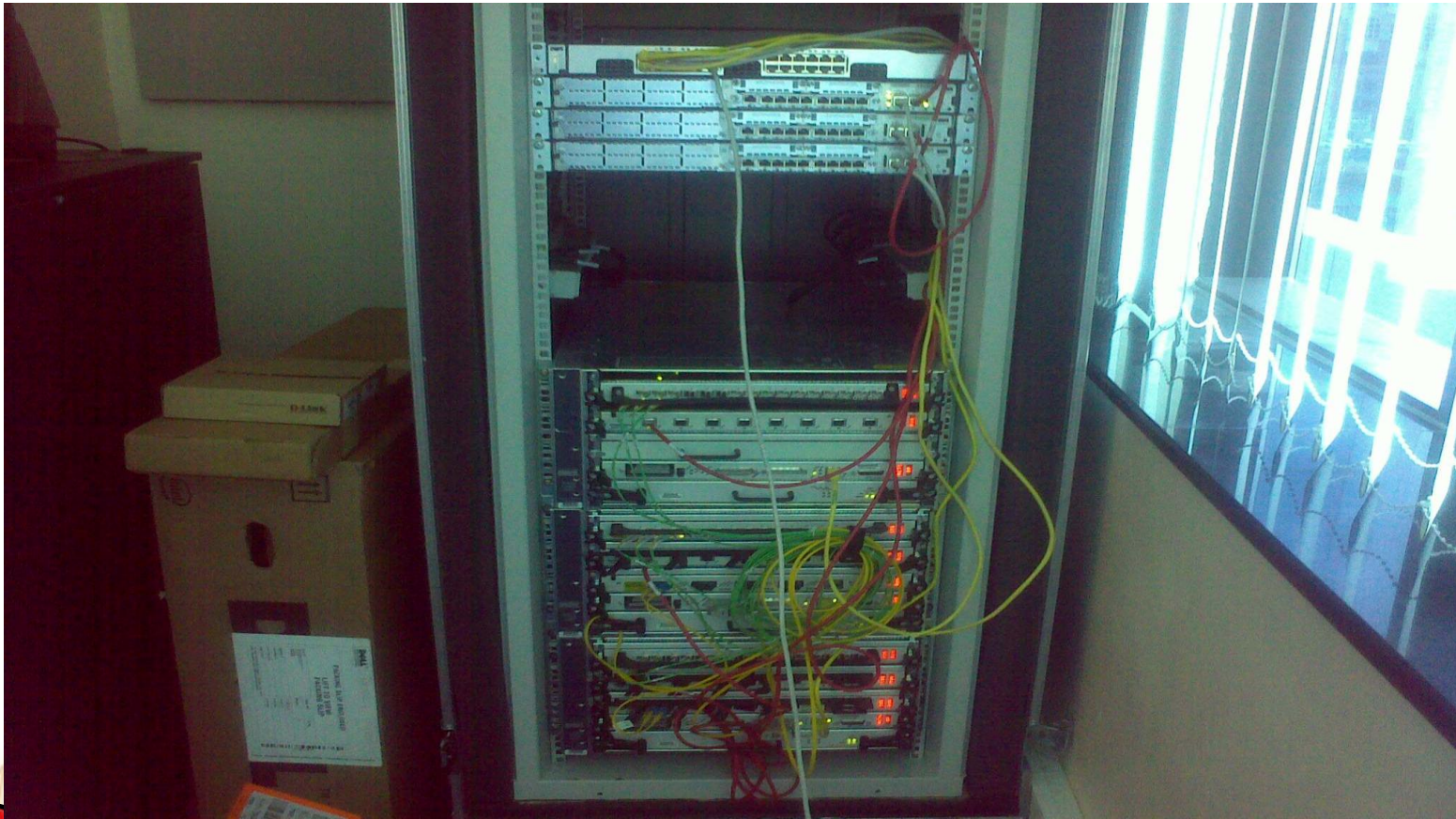
