Brief Introduction of Author(s)

We are trying to change the way of Abuse Handling and the way of collaboration between networks owners.



The Objective(s) of the Proposal

- Too many places for abuse information available
 - one or more abuse-mailbox attributes per inet(6)num or aut-num
 - endless remarks and trouble fields possible
 - → network owners are confused what to use
 - → automatic parsing is nearly impossible
- No dedicated abuse contact information published
 - Reports are send to tech-c or admin-c as suggested by AfriNIC
 - → High volume of reports on personal email accounts.
 - → Forwarding, if done, wastes time.



Situation at other RIRs

ARIN

An abuse-POC exists for Organizational ID identifiers.

LacNIC

An abuse-c exists for aut-num and inet(6)num objects.

APNIC

This policy proposal found consensus at the APNIC Meeting in Kuala Lumpur March 1st to 5th 2010. And reached full consensus on sMay 8th 2010.

RIPE

An optional IRT (Incident Response Team) object can be linked to inetnum and inet6num objects. This proposal was suggested to RIPE beginning of May.



Summary of the Proposal

- add a mandatory reference to IRT objects in
 - inetnum objects
 - inet6num objects
 - aut-num objects
- as single point of information for abuse contacts



Details 1

- Institute a mandatory IRT Object for
 - inetnum objects
 - inet6num objects
 - as-num objects
- Implementation will be done
 - if organization will update inetnum, inet6num or as-num objects.
 - a new inetnum, inet6num or as-num object is created.



Details 2

- Have a mandatory abuse-mailbox field in the IRT object.
 - e-mail field shall be used for personal communication with the abuse contact.
 - abuse-mailbox field shall be used for all kinds of abuse reports.



Details 3

- Delete abuse-mailbox fields in all objects without IRT Object.
- Delete the trouble field everywhere.
- Start cleanup process in 2011.



Advantages

- Networks will be able to supply their own contact information for abuse departments.
- Abuse complaints will not be sent to the "wrong" contact any more.
- There will be more flexibility. Faster abuse handling will be possible leading to less abusive behavior.



Disadvantages

- Data Accuracy
 - is a problem in all objects.
 - is not the aim of this proposal.
 - will be faced in another policy proposal.
