African ccTLD Support

- In 2010, AfriNIC started operating an IPv4/6 dual-stacked anycast DNS network for its own operations.
- Our intention is to make this available free to African ccTLD operators and operators of critical Internet infrastructure to improve resiliency of the Internet in our region.

 - -Yes, really...you can trust us... :-)




RFC 5885

- Feb 2011; changes to the Root zone reflect AfriNIC carrying in-addr.arpa on their nameservers.


