ICANN Update – new gTLDs



- New gTLDs
 - **New gTLD Customer Service Center** will offer more services: new, multi-lingual Knowledge Base that offers a range of reference materials. Applicants will be able to communicate with customer service in the 6 UN languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian, and Spanish).
 - **ICANN Seeks Independent Objector:** The Independent Objector shall act in the public interest when determining whether to file an objection to a given application for a new gTLD (<http://www.icann.org/en/topics/new-gtlds/independent-objector-position-description-21nov11-en.pdf>)

ICANN Update - IDNs



- Version 3.0 of IDN Guidelines: Guidelines are a list of general standards that all top-level domain registries deploying IDNs are required to follow based on the Internationalized Domain Names for Applications (IDNA) protocol standard from the IETF.

- IDNs variants project:
Applicants may declare variant strings for the TLD in its application.
No variant TLD strings are delegated until variant management solutions are developed and implemented

ICANN Update - NomCom



- 2012 ICANN Nominating Committee (NomCom) headed by Vanda Sacartezini
- 2012 NomCom will select:
 - Three members of the ICANN Board of Directors
 - Two members of the At Large Advisory Committee (Europe and North America regions)
 - One member of the Council of the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO)
 - One member of the Council of the Country-Code Names Supporting Organization (ccNSO)
 - Those selected by the 2012 NomCom will take their seats at the conclusion of the 2012 ICANN Annual General Meeting, 19 October 2012 in Toronto, Canada.

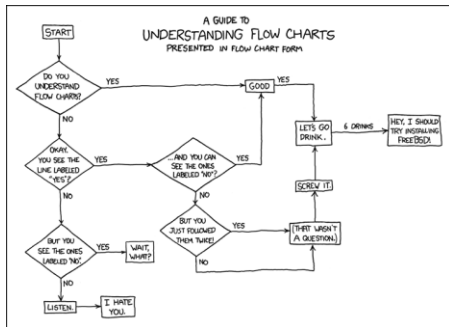
The US DoC NTIA published RFP for the IANA Functions on November 10, 2011 with responses due by RFP Dec

- We're setting new performance targets



Root zone automation

The new web interface to root zone management was launched in August

100% of TLD operators now have credentials for the system
