

# Statistical facts about Africa!!

#### The True Size of Africa

In addition to the well known social issues of illiteracy and innumeracy, there also should be such a concept as "immappancy", meaning insufficient geographical knowledge.

A survey with random American schoolkids let them guess the population and land area of their country. Not entirely unexpected, but still rather unsettling, the majority chose "1-2 billion" and "largest in the world", respectively.

Even with Asian and European college students, geographical estimates were often off by factors of 2-3. This is partly due to the highly distorted nature of the predominantly used mapping projections (such as Mercutor).

A particularly extreme example is the worldwide misjudgement of the true size of Africa. This single image tries to embody the massive scale, which is larger than the USA, Chino, India, Japan and all of Europe...... combined:

 There are over 1 billion people living in Africa, which represents 15% of the world's population.

#### **Fact**

 Only 11.5% of the people living in Africa are currently online.

#### **Fact**

Africa represents 5.6% of the total world's users.

#### **Fact**

 Despite a slowdown in the global economic recovery and an increasingly difficult global environment, Sub-Saharan African countries are continuing to post solid growth.


#### **Fact**

• African countries are amongst the fastest growing countries in the world: Ghana is projected to grow by well over 10% this year; and nearly 40% of the countries in the region are likely to see 6% or higher growth rates.



#### **IPv6 Networks Readiness**





#### **Fact**

There are 33 African counties that have at least one IPv6 allocation.

#### **Fact**

In 2005 there were only 4 networks in Africa that had IPv6 prefixes and most of them were not visible to the Internet. Today we have more than 240 networks with IPv6 prefixes assigned!



#### **Fact**

 West and Central Africa represents one of the fastest-growing mobile communications market in sub-Saharan Africa over the past few years with more than 3 mobile operators in each country and massive infrastructure development.

#### **Fact**

 Over 90% of the internet traffic in Kenya is done via mobile operators, meaning 3G, Edge or GPRS.
