What is the NRO-NC?

- NRO = Number Resource Organization
 - coordination between RIRs
- NRO-NC = NRO Number Council
 - Members are appointed/elected by the RIRs
 - http://www.nro.net/about/number-council.html



What is the ASO-AC?

- ASO = Address Supporting Organization
 - ▶ One of the ICANN "Supporting Organizations"
- ASO-AC = ASO Address Council
 - Advises ICANN on number resource policy issues
 - http://aso.icann.org/



NRO-NC = ASO-AC

- In terms of an MoU between ICANN and the NRO, the NRO-NC fulfils the role, responsibility, and functions of the ASO-AC
 - http://www.aso.icann.org/docs/aso-mou2004.html
- Effectively, members are elected/appointed to the NRO-NC, but also serve as the ASO-AC



ASO-AC/NRO-NC Membership

- 15 Members
 - 3 from each RIR
 - 2 elected by community
 - 1 appointed by Board
 - Typically serve three-year terms, but different RIRs have different procedures for electing or appointing members.

Tasks of the ASO-AC

- Appoint seats 9 and 10 to ICANN Board of Directors
 - staggered three-year terms
- Serve on various ICANN bodies as needed
 - e.g. NomCom, Review Teams
- Process "Global Policy Proposals"
 - Assure ICANN Board that process has been followed
- Advise ICANN Board on number resources



ICANN Board of Directors

- Seat 9: Ray Plzak
 - serving from mid-2009 to mid-2012
- Seat 10: Kuo-Wei Wu
 - serving from mid-2010 to mid-2013
- Seat 9 is up for re-election in 2012



ICANN Board Seat 9 Appointment

- Seat Nine selection schedule
 - ▶ Nomination Phase 1 November 2011 to 16 January 2012
 - Comment Phase 17 January 2012 19 April 2012
 - ▶ Interview Phase 20 February 2012 19 April 2012
 - ▶ Selection Phase 23 April 2012 -14 May 2012
 - Due Diligence Review 15 May 2012 15 June 2012
- Selection Announced 18 June 2012
 - (or earlier based on completion date of due diligence review)
- Candidates:
 - Thomas Eric Brunner-Williams
 - Martin J. Levy
 - William Manning
 - Raymond Alan Plzak

GPP-IPv4-2011 - Adopted

Global Policy Proposal for Post Exhaustion IPv4 Allocation Mechanisms by IANA

- AfriNIC's version of this policy is AFPUB-2011-v4-004
- Describes how IANA will allocate IPv4 resources now that the central pool is exhausted
 - Establish a Recovered IPv4 Pool, containing remaining fragments and returned space
 - ▶ 1/5 of Recovered IPv4 Pool to each RIR every IPv4 Allocation Period (6 months)
- Has been passed in all regions
- Ratified by ICANN Board on 6 May 2012

GPP-IPv4-2010 - Unlikely to advance

Global Policy Proposal for the Allocation of IPv4 by IANA Post Exhaustion

- Targets the same problem domain as GPP-IPv4-2010
- AfriNIC's version of this policy is AFPUB-2010-v4-003
- Expired in the AfriNIC region
- Adopted in the ARIN region
- Abandoned in APNIC, LACNIC, RIPE-NCC regions
