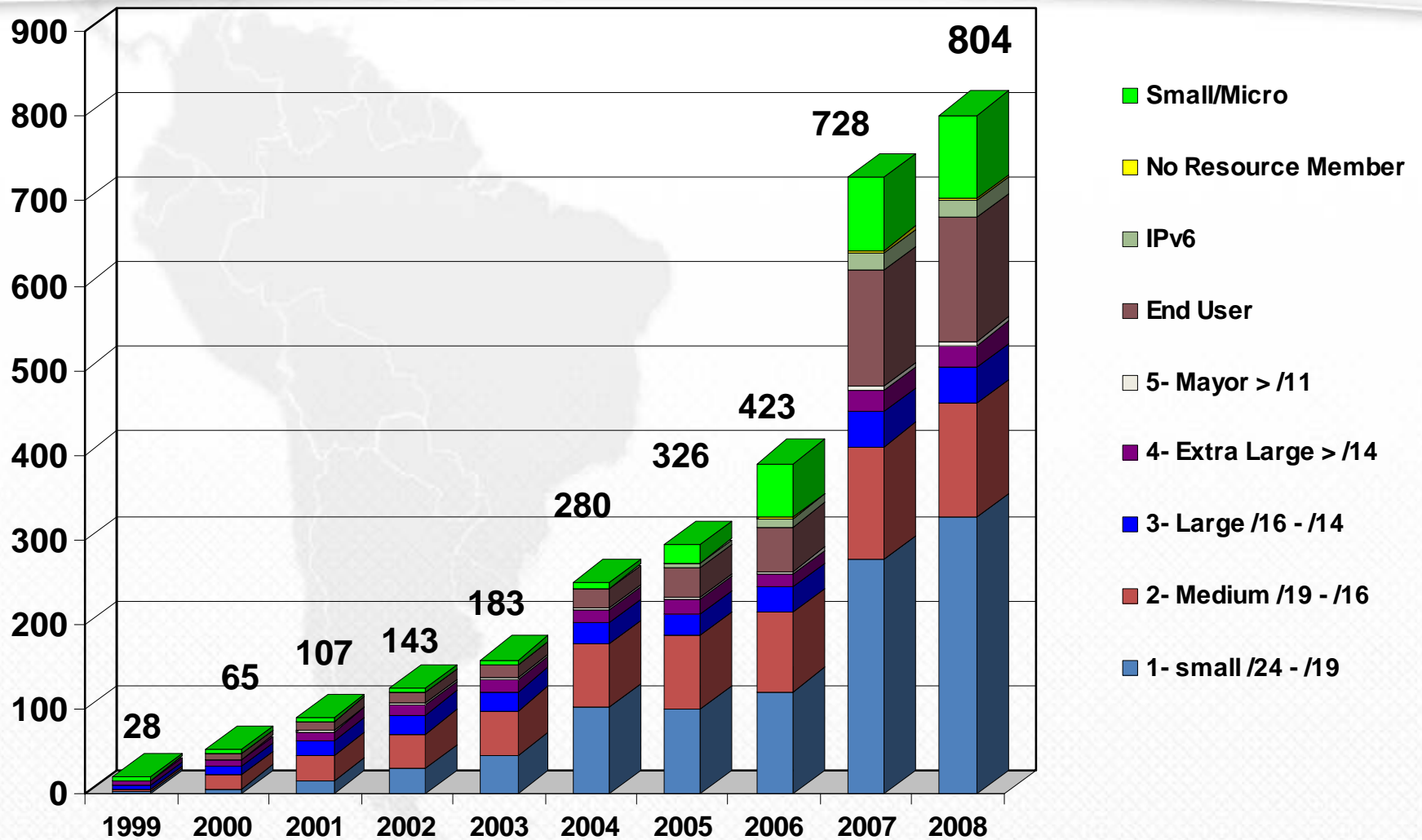


# LACNIC's 5th Anniversary (31/10/2007)



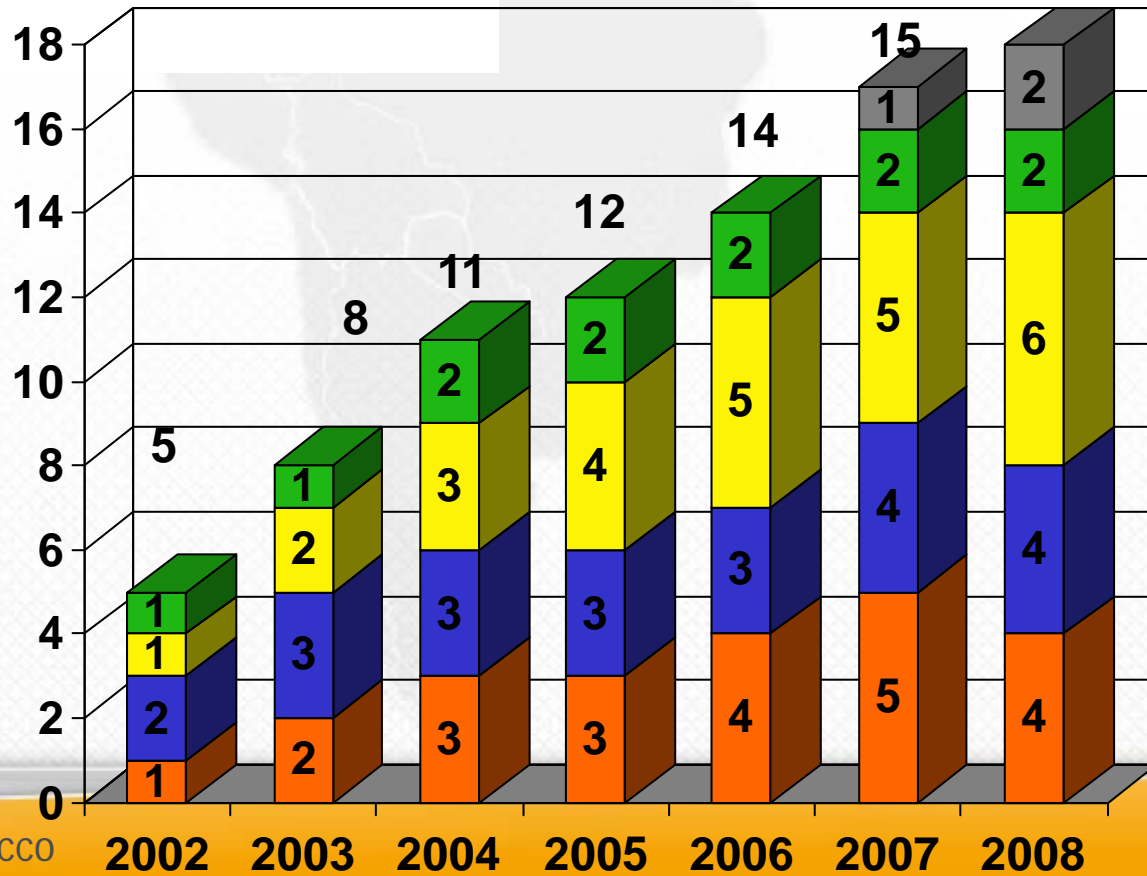

- ◆ 2002 – US\$ 150.000
- ◆ 2007 – US\$ 1.5 millions
- ◆ 2008 – US\$ 1.7 millions.

- ◆ Total: More than US\$ 1 million in 4 years.

- ◆ 41 projects already funded.





## LACNIC and eLAC

- ◆ It was the result of the Regional Conference of Governments, in 2005 (Río de Janeiro). eLAC-2007 includes 70 goals.
- ◆ eLAC-2007 process is runs by the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC)
- ◆ LACNIC has activities that directly contribute with the achievement of 25 of the eLAC-2007 objectives probing that LACNIC is an active actor in the development of the Information Society in our region.
- ◆ LACNIC usually participates in every eLAC activities, working groups, etc. Specially in those working groups related to the technical stability of Internet.





## LACNIC and eLAC-2010

- ◆ **A new round of goals set by the governments to be achieved by 2010.**
- ◆ **LACNIC participated during the debates and the elaboration of the 83 goals of the San Salvador Commitment.**
- ◆ **Particularly, goal 15 referring to IPv6:**  
*“ Carry out actions geared towards promoting the adoption of the IPv6 protocol at the public and private levels with a view to making all public services offered via the IP protocol, as appropriate, available on IPv6 and ensuring that the main State infrastructure and applications are IPv6-compatible. Actions to be implemented will, to the extent possible, include the early implementation of requirements to ensure that government procure equipment and applications that are IPv6-compatible.”*

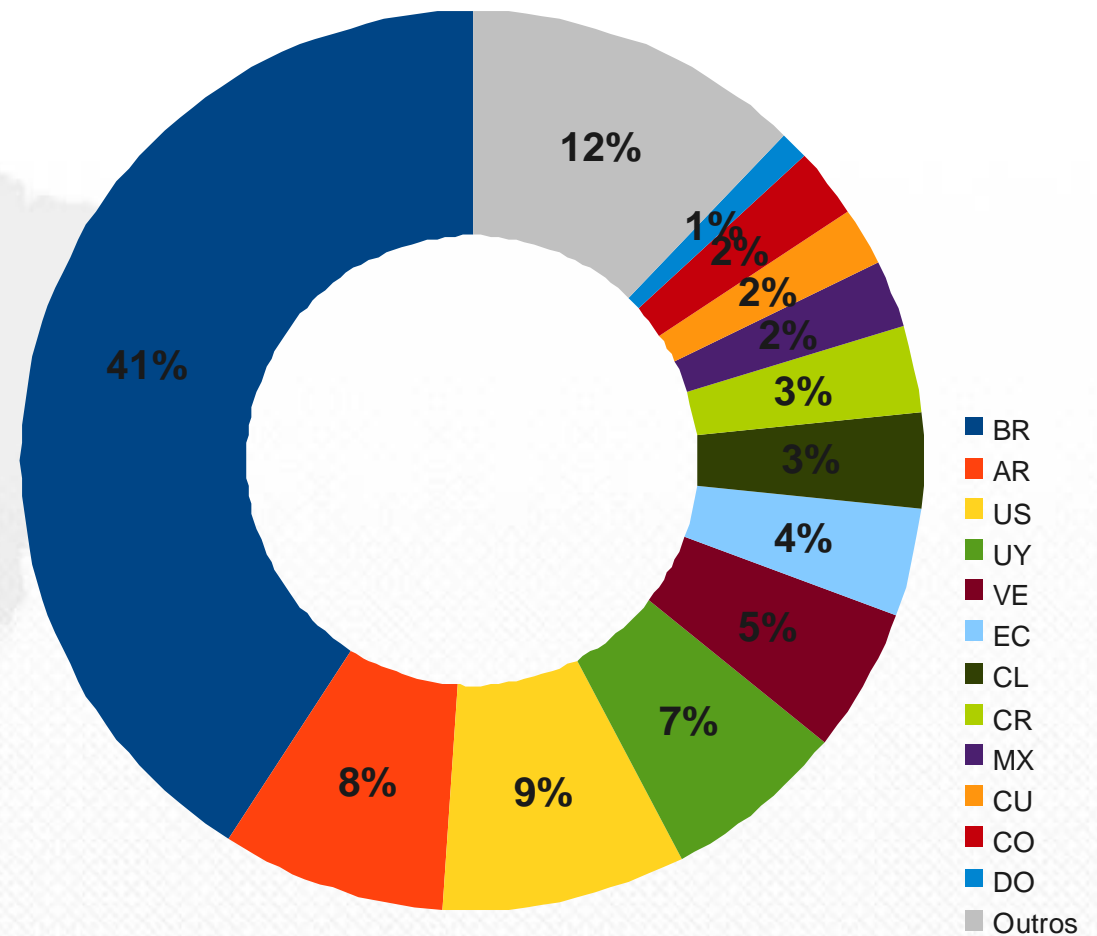
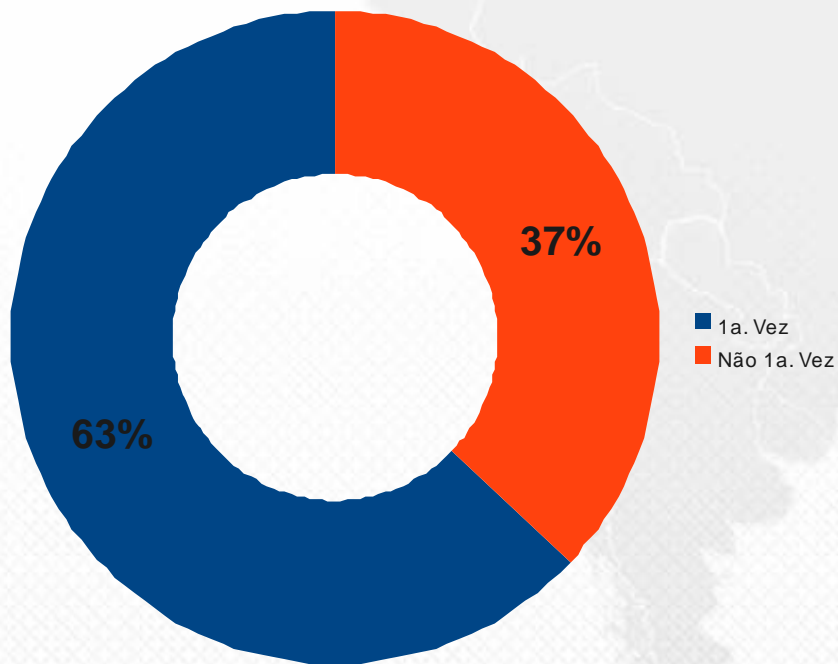
## LACNIC XI Report

- ◆ ccTLD, IXP, Security, IPv6, ISOC chapters, LACNOG had their meeting during LACNIC XI
- ◆ IPv4 Depletion panel (Board)



# LACNIC XI / participants

  - ◆ 159 Members





## Webcasting

- ◆ **Transmission in the 3 LACNIC Languages: Spanish, English and Portuguese during the whole meeting**
  - ◆ **IPv4/IPv6**
  - ◆ **86 local attendees (41 IPv6), 181 remote (5 IPv6)**





## LACNIC XI: Discussed Policies

- ◆ 2007-01: IPv6 Block Announcement (back to the list)
- ◆ 2008-01: Global Policy (the last 5 x /8). Approved.
- ◆ 2008-04: This policy proposes reserving the last /13 from LACNIC pool for “new allocations”. Approved.
- ◆ 2008-02 and 2008-03: IPv6 PI Allocations. Back to the list.
- ◆ New PDP document with “expedite process”. Approved.
- ◆ Working group present a complete revision of policies



## Projects under way:

- ◆ New System to be release in 2008. ERX with NIRs and LIRs.
- ◆ New CRM Tool.
- ◆ New Network infrastructure at Montevideo and San Pablo.
- ◆ NRO-ECG Projects:
  - ◆ DNSSEC.
