

- The NRO acts as the ICANN Address Supporting Organization (ASO).
- An elected body called the NRO Number Council (NRO NC) serves as the ASO Address Council (ASO AC), it oversees recommendations on IP address policy, including the management of policy development activities, and appoints members to the ICANN Board of Directors.
