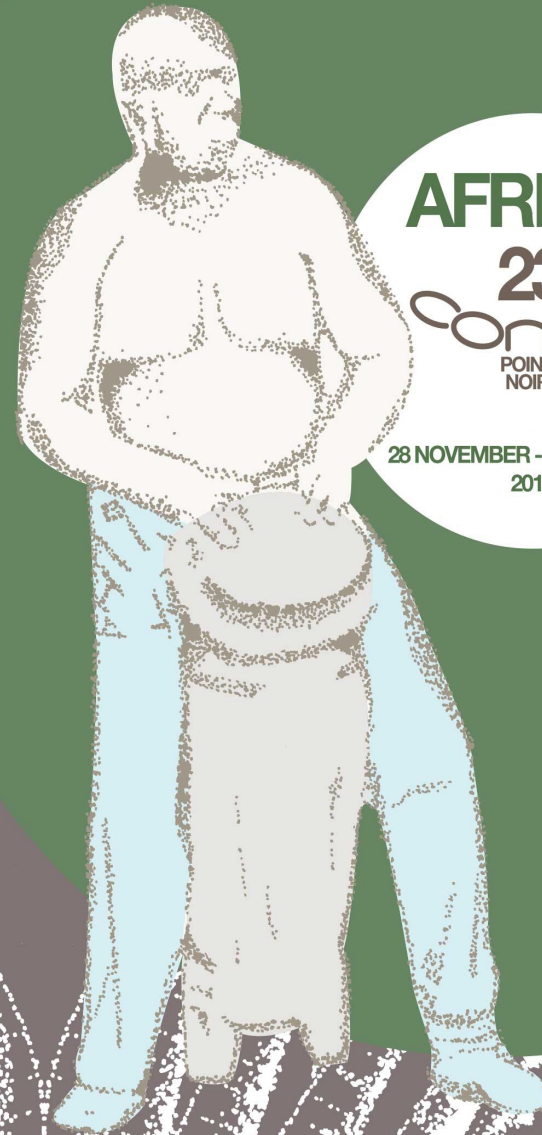

Statistics - Requests

- Since 1 January 2015
 - ~ 1900 tickets handled by Registration Services Team
 - ~ 181 new-member requests
 - ~ 330 additional resource requests(IPv4, IPv6 and ASN)
- Prefix size currently under evaluation sum to ~/9 in 25 open tickets

- **4404 /32s & 43 /48s IPv6 prefixes**

Guidelines Resource Issuance

- AFRINIC will continue to issue resource prefixes and do its best to adhere to the aggregation principle in the policies
- In case of instances where aggregation is not possible, resource members may be issued with > 1 prefix to make up the count of IP addresses approved



Statistics - Services

Service support covers afrinic database, reverse delegations, assignments registration and since Q3-2015 , IRR

Route objects in AFRINIC IRR increased from 426 in June 2015 to 624

32 route6 objects

Number of members not compliant with existing reverse DNS policy – 181 in June 2015 , now 136

Hostmasters' Observations

- Incomplete applications submitted
- Slow and delayed response from members.
- Reluctance of applicants/resource members to provide supporting information.
- ~14 worth of IPv4 addresses in stalled tickets due to no response from requestors in 2015
- ~200 Resource members having received allocations since 2005 have < 80% usage

~ 10 “Teach and Approve” per month regarding IP addressing Plan and Assignment registration on whois database.
