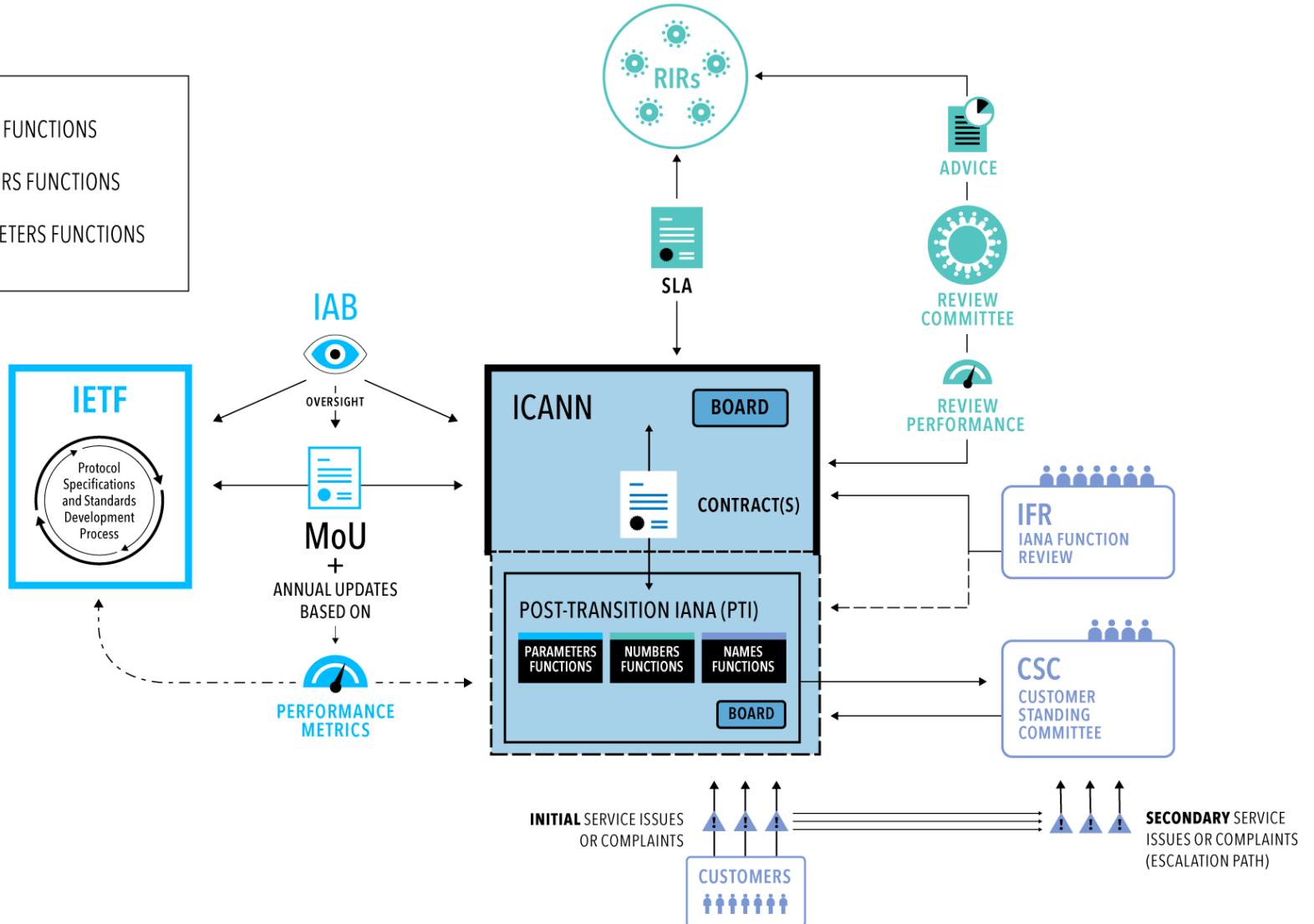
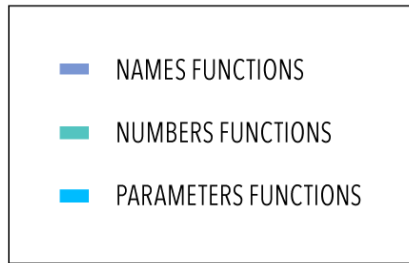

# CRISP TEAM COMMITMENT

- Committed to the success of this transition
- Transparency throughout the discussion process,
- Respect principles in the CRISP proposal:  
separation of policy dev and operational roles;  
description of services provided to RIRs;  
transparent and accountable reporting by IFO;  
security, performance & audit requirements;  
Review of IANA operations; failure to perform;  
term of contract; continuity of operations; IPR;  
dispute resolution; cost based fee

# CRISP work post submission

- Present, effectively communicate and vouch for proposal, e.g. Improved CRISP website
- Ensure proposal integrity: IPR, Termination clause, SLA, Review committee
- Actively participate in overall IANA stewardship transition process, Representing the Numbers proposal, Coordination with other communities, Ensuring we meet transition timelines



28 NOVEMBER - 4 DECEMBER

- Sep 2015: IANA Functions contract extended by one year
- Oct 2015: ICG has completed combined proposal
- January 2016: CCWG Accountability expected to complete its work
- Submission of ICG and CCWG Accountability reports to NTIA by ICANN board
- September 2016: Expiry of IANA Functions contract

## Where are we?

- The Names portion of this proposal is conditioned on ICANN-level accountability mechanisms currently under development in the Cross Community Working Group on Enhancing ICANN Accountability (CCWG). The Numbers and Protocol Parameters portions of the proposal are complete, ready for implementation, and have no dependencies on the work of the CCWG or other remaining processes.

## Number Proposal components

- IANA function stability & reliability: ICANN to continue as the IANA Numbering Services Operator
- SLA – last draft review: Replace role of NTIA with the RIRs
- Review Committee – formation of RC
- IPR – cross community negotiations

- Intellectual Property Rights
  - We want IPR framework finalized before submission to the NTIA
  - IANAPLAN has produced a high level description
  - CRISP has published its minimum requirements

- Termination clause: Either party can terminate agreement
- SLA development to take place in public
- Final public call for comments

## REVIEW COMMITTEE FUNCTIONS

28 NOVEMBER - 4 DECEMBER

- Advise and assist NRO EC in its periodic review of the service level of the IANA Numbering Services provided to the Internet Number Community.
- Report to the NRO EC concerns regarding the performance of the IANA Numbering Services Operator, including any observed failure or near failure by the IANA Numbering Services Operator to meet its obligations under the SLA
- Submit report to the NRO EC once per year

# RC limitations

- The Review Committee does not have any power to commit the NRO EC to any recommendation or decision made by it, except where and to the extent that it has express delegated authority from the NRO EC



# RC Composition

28 NOVEMBER - 4 DECEMBER

- 15 members total
- two community appointees – Not staff
- one RIR staff from each region – non voting
- RIRs to appoint RC members by methods of their own choosing.
- RIRs shall determine the term of appointment for its RC members.
- Each RIR may, from time to time, remove and/or replace any of its appointed RC members



# RC Proceedings

28 NOVEMBER - 4 DECEMBER

- Meet entirely via teleconference
- Meetings must be held at least twice each year, and more often as required
- RC final report and/or recommendation to the NRO EC, it must first consult and seek the feedback and comment from the Internet Number Community

- Community input: AFRINIC ASO-AC members
- Board decision: SGM

## OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Term limits of RC members
- RC's mandate to start after transition
